ANNUAL REPORT



2021 was an exciting year for Inspire! We reached 33 students with our housing program, weekly therapy sessions, and inperson life skills classes. We were thrilled to expand our Inspired Scholars program to give ten foster youth attending various 4-year universities stipends of \$500 per month and professional coaching sessions. As we marked the second year of this program, we also celebrated with one of our Inspired Scholars who graduated from Norco College and transferred to UC Berkeley. In 2021, we launched WeCare Packages, providing self-care kits to 200 foster youth attending college to encourage them before their finals.

We are grateful to everyone who attended our in-person gala, Thanksgiving dinner, Christmas party and to everyone who supported us this past year. We look forward to what 2022 has in store as we help more students reach their education, employment, and personal goals.


